




Salish Nations, British Columbia and Washington State cooperatively designate and co-manage the Salish Sea as a Marine Sanctuary, surrounded by a community-connecting Coastal Trail.



ARINE SANCTUARIES are protected areas where elevated standards of conduct protect and restore wildlife habitat and populations. Pollution to waterways is reduced and eco-tourism revenues are multiplied. An excellent example is Monterey Bay Marine Sanctuary in California.
